## REPORT

The Embassy of India, Seoul under aegis of the flagship programme of Oversees Indian Affairs, Ministry of External Affairs - "Promotion of Cultural Ties with Diaspora" organized a cultural event consisting of Indian cultural booths for promoting Diaspora engagements in Republic of Korea on October 8-9, 2022 at the Nami Island. The cultural booths showcased an array of handicraft items, and hands-on experience about Indian culture for the members of Indian community and 'friends of Korea. The event was India' in organized as part of initiatives to cultivate and engage with the Indian community members residing Republic of Korea.







The event aimed at strengthening ties with the overseas Indian community members and support their efforts to preserve, maintain and reinforce bonds with India and at the same time promote awareness about the diversity and unique cultural heritage of India in Republic of Korea.
